

Urbana Adult Education CNA Student Dress Code



The purpose of this course is to train students to work as professional CNAs in a clinical environment. This training includes the practice of dressing appropriately for the job.

CNA Student UNIFORM

Beginning the second week of class, CNA students are required to wear the following uniform daily*:



Scrub Tops: Solid Wine Color *ONLY*

ScrubPants: Solid Wine Color *ONLY*

Shoes: Solid White, Black, or Burgundy (closed toe, no mesh)

Watch: With a second hand (No smart watches)

* Name tags must be worn every day, beginning on the first day of class

In addition to wearing the above uniform, CNA students are also required to follow the dress code and personal care policy as outlined below, for the duration of the course:

Personal hygiene

- Daily attention to personal hygiene is expected, including **regular bathing, oral hygiene, and use of deodorant as often as necessary.**
- Makeup, if worn, should be applied in moderation.
- False eyelashes are not permitted.
- Perfume, aftershave, cologne, and scented lotions should not be worn.

Hair

- Long hair must be contained so as not to drape into or interfere in the work area.
- Must be clean and styled in a professional manner.
- Natural tone/colors only. No extreme looks will be allowed (multi-colors, neon colors, extremes in bleaching, dyeing or tinting.)
- Beards and mustaches should be cleaned and neatly trimmed.
- Hair Accessories must be minimal and complimentary to attire. Hats, caps, or other head coverings will not be permitted, except for medical or religious reasons.



Fingernails

- Should be carefully filed and trimmed to no more than ¼" long.
- Should not be visible when viewed from the palm side of the hands (in order to prevent injury to patients).
- Artificial nails or fingernail jewelry cannot be worn when providing direct patient care, directly supervising patient care, or while in contact with patient care supplies, equipment, medications, or food.

Jewelry

- Dangling jewelry will not be permitted in direct patient care, including long necklaces or earrings.
- Large rings may not be worn. One ring per hand, with the wedding set counted as one.
- Piercings are limited to the ears, with a total of one earring per ear.
- Other visible body or facial piercings are not considered appropriate from the perspective of patients and customers, and therefore are not allowed (includes tongue, nose, eyebrow, etc.)
- Jewelry should be contained or removed during sterile and/or invasive procedures

Tattoos and Body Art

- During clinical rotations, tattoos and/or body art must be appropriately covered at all times.
- During the classroom portion, exceptions to this rule may be made at the discretion of the CNA Instructor.

Personal Clothing

- Socks MUST be worn, and should be white, nude, or the color of scrub pants worn.
- Shoes must be closed toe, clean, soft soled, and in good repair.
- Shoes should be of a material that is easily cleaned when soiled. Shoes should be solid white, black, or burgundy.
- Undergarments must be worn and should not be visible through the uniform.
- Clothing should fit appropriately (not too tight or excessively baggy)
- Clothing style/cut should allow for full skin coverage when bending, reaching or lifting.
- Clothing should be laundered daily, unwrinkled, not visibly soiled/stained, and in good repair.
- Uniforms that become soiled with blood or body fluids must be changed.

Scrub pants

- Scrub pants should be full length. Pants must be neatly hemmed and should not drag the floor
- No pants with rivets.

Jackets/Tops

- Only white, grey, or black shirts may be worn beneath the scrub top (camisole, tank, turtleneck, long/short sleeve knit).
- Jackets/hoodies should not be worn in the clinical setting.
