

CNA BRIDGE CLASS Process and Dates 2023-2024

Purpose:

- To introduce students to the health care field and the duties of a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA).
- To prepare students for our CNA program by improving their literacy skills.
- This is an introduction class and will not result in state CNA certification.

Requirements:

- Commit to at least 90% attendance for 6 weeks of class (twice a week for 3 hours/class).
- Complete our registration and testing process.
 - TABE 11/12 score of NRS 3 or higher
 - CASAS (ESL) score of NRS 4 or higher
- If interested in pursuing our CNA course, you must have a TAX ID OR SSN and be able to pass a background check.

CNA Bridge to CNA Class

Students who successfully complete the CNA Bridge class will be eligible for enrollment in our CNA certificated program. In order to successfully complete the class, students must:

- Attain at least a 90% attendance rate.
- Earn at least an 80% average on weekly quizzes and the final exam.
- Increase their TABE or CASAS score by at least 1 NRS level.

Enrollment Steps

1. Complete the online registration form.
2. Check your email for information about scheduling an assessment appointment.
3. Attend your scheduled assessment appointment. During the assessment appointment, you will take the TABE 11/12 (Reading) test or the CASAS (English) test.
